Silt Committee Report

Following the results of the special assessment referendum to finance the proposed dredging project, the silt committee met on April 24th to discuss other options for silt removal. The committee decided to focus on trying to develop a plan for conventional dredging. This would be done by pumping the silt to an area within the watershed of Dunlap Lake, which would let us do away with the mechanical dewatering process. If we can do this it would drop the cost considerably because it would eliminate the dewatering cost and the trucking cost. The problem is finding the property close by that is accessible and then being able to lease or buy that property.

We also met with the City of Edwardsville & the Illinois Department of Agriculture to see if they could help us. They were very helpful and able to give us some good ideas on where to look for some possible financial help and possible property owners to talk to in our watershed.

We are working to solve our silt problem, and we are always open to new ideas or help that our property owners can give. Please feel free to contact any of the silt committee members with that help or idea.

Commons Report

The storm damaged trees and limbs on commons lots around the lake are being removed. The removal of debris should be completed by the end of May. We have again accepted a bid from Greenside Lawn Service to take care of the mowing of all commons lots. We are also seeking a contractor to remove logs, limbs and other debris from the lake.

Safety & Boating Information

Requirements of boat owners: All boats on the lake are required to have a Dunlap sticker to identify your boat and to identify that you are a property owner/resident of the association. You are responsible for applying your sticker properly, and following proper boating procedures and restrictions. You may transfer ownership of your boat sticker if you are selling your boat to another Dunlap Lake property owner by using the application below for a \$5.00 fee. If you are selling your boat off the lake to a nonresident, please do not forget to remove your Dunlap Lake sticker.

Note: Material used to make boat stickers have risen in cost and will cost the association more to provide, so we will soon see an increase in the cost, and notify you accordingly. If your sticker has worn off or is no longer visible, please contact Safety for a new sticker. If you have any questions, please feel free to call a committee member for help. **Access to the Boat Ramp is located on Barnett Drive.** Please call a committee member 48 hours before needing access to the ramp so it can be opened for loading/unloading.

Boating restrictions are as follows:

Outboard motors used on fishing boats are limited to a maximum of 7.5 horsepower. Pontoon boats are allowed motors with a maximum horsepower of 9.9. This protects our shorelines and is for safety purposes. Only one outboard motor mounted on each boat is allowed. All boats including canoes, paddle boats, fishing boats, and wind driven boats are required to have a Dunlap Lake sticker. No pontoons over 24 feet. Any craft on the water from sunset to sunrise must have running lights and/or anchor lights. All boats should be in compliance with Coast Guard regulations, including adequate life jackets for all passengers on board and a fire extinguisher on motored boats.

Remember that non-motored boats have "right of way" before motored boats. **Be Safe & Enjoy!**
